

The Taylor's Dryland Wildflower Mixture is made up of 23 individual species. These flowers are designed to flourish in dryer climates or areas that do not get moisture on a regular basis. The mix is made up of 50% annuals and 50% biennials/perennials to give a wide variety of colourful flowers for the first season as well as following years. The wildflower bed will reach a height of approximately 36 – 48 inches under normal conditions.
