

Taylor's Low Grow Wildflower Mix is made up of 24 species, of which approximately 65% are annual and 35% are perennial flower seeds. These wildflowers are chosen for their natural beauty, long flowering periods and low growing characteristics. The mix will grow to a height of approximately 18 - 24 inches under normal growing conditions. It is ideal for an area where the flower beauty is wanted along with a shorter flowering bed.
