

The Taylor's Mountain Wildflower Mix is designed to do exceptionally well in the mountain areas of the US and Canada. This mix consists of 20 species, 40% annuals and 60% biennials or perennials which means the mix will give colour the first year and prosper for many following years. Many of these varieties do very well in higher elevations with limited moisture. The Mountain Mix will reach a height of approximately 36 - 48 inches under normal conditions.
