

Our Coastal Pollinator Wildflower mix is designed to attract native bees, bumble bees and other beneficial insects with nectar and pollen-rich flowers. Bees are particularly attracted to flowers that are blue, purple, violet, white and yellow. This mix consists of 14 introduced and native coastal species: 58% annuals and 42% perennials that bloom from mid-spring into fall. These species range in height of approximately 19-78 inches.
