**QUICK FACTS**

**HANCOCK** perennial ryegrass is a new signature variety directed towards adapting to climate change. Because resources for maintaining professional turf continue to be limited, choosing the right variety is critical to maintaining healthy turf. Recent results from the National Turf Evaluation Program put Hancock in the top ten for salt and wear tolerance, with good resistance to most common turf diseases. Hancock forms a beautiful dark green turf, with early spring greenup, fine leaves and excellent summer density.



**ADAPTATION**

**HANCOCK** is designed for areas where reclaimed water will be used for irrigation. Applied as a straight or using Hancock in blends and mixes is a beneficial enhancement for improving marginally salt tolerant turf. It is excellent for use on golf course tees and fairways, sports venues, parks and home lawns.
