QUICK FACTS: *Sombrero* is an 'Aggressive' type Kentucky bluegrass with excellent wear, heat and drought tolerance. Quick to establish, the hardy, dense, durable turf produced easily repairs itself due to an extensive rhizome system. *Sombrero* features a medium dark green color and is well adapted to a wide range of soils and climatic conditions. The dense turf successfully reduces the invasion of *Poa annua*. *Sombrero* also has very good resistance to *Typhula* blight, leaf spot, necrotic ring spot and other common turf diseases.

ADAPTATION: *Sombrero* is widely adapted throughout the cool, humid regions of North America. Slow vertical growth and wear tolerance make *Sombrero* suitable for parks, playgrounds, lawns and roadside restoration.

SEEDING RATE: 3-5 lbs. p/1000 sq. ft.
